Mistake 1:

Mistake 2:

Ignoring local references.

Fix:

Include towns, projects and local examples.

Mistake 3:

Inconsistent business details.

Fix:

Standardise all listings.

Mistake 4:

Writing for search engines only.

Fix:

Write for humans first.

Mistake 5:

Publishing once then stopping.

Fix:

Follow a weekly schedule.

Mistake 6:

Ignoring reviews.

Fix:

Request reviews after every completed job.

Mistake 7:

Tracking nothing.

Fix:

Measure progress monthly.

Example 1: Local Web Design Agency

Starting point:

Few enquiries despite good rankings.

Framework application:

Built authority articles.

Created FAQs.

Added local project case studies.

Expanded mentions through business organisations.

Result:

40% increase in enquiries within three months.

Invisible outside Google Maps.

Framework application:

Created service pages.

Added location content.

Collected reviews.

Improved directory consistency.

Result:

More visibility across AI generated recommendations.

Starting point:

Limited online presence.

Framework application:

Published expert guides.

Added project showcases.

Secured local press mentions.

Improved authority signals.

Result:

Increased organic traffic and enquiries.
