Check items as complete. If you cannot check it, do not proceed.

CHECKLIST #1: THE SETUP CHECKLIST

Use this before starting any AI Search Engine Optimisation for local websites project.

- Record business name exactly as registered
- Record primary telephone number
- Record website URL
- Record primary service categories
- Record service locations

Why these matter:

AI Search Engine Optimisation for local websites relies on consistency. Inaccurate business information weakens trust signals.

- Create Google Business Profile access
- Create Search Console access
- Create Analytics access
- Create business directory tracking sheet
- Create content planning sheet

Why these matter:

Tracking systems prevent missing important optimisation opportunities.

- Document top five competitors
- List top ten customer questions
- Collect five customer reviews
- Create author profile
- Create business description

CHECKLIST #2: THE EXECUTION CHECKLIST

SECTION: Business Foundations

- Publish business description
- Add opening hours
- Add contact details
- Add service areas
- Upload business photographs

Why these matter:

AI systems need complete business information.

SECTION: Authority Building

- Publish expert article
- Publish FAQ page
- Publish service page
- Add author biography
- Add customer review

Why these matter:

Authority signals improve trust.

SECTION: Local Relevance

- Add town names
- Add service locations
- Publish local case study
- Add project photographs
- Add local testimonials

Why these matter:

Local relevance improves visibility.

SECTION: Citation Building

- Submit business directory listing
- Submit industry directory listing
- Submit chamber listing
- Record listing URL
- Verify published listing

Why these matter:

Citations strengthen business credibility.

SECTION: Monitoring

- Connect Search Console
- Connect Analytics
- Record baseline traffic
- Record baseline enquiries
- Record baseline rankings

Why these matter:

Measurement allows improvement.

CHECKLIST #3: QUALITY CONTROL CHECKLIST

- Verify telephone number matches website
- Verify address matches listings
- Verify email address works
- Verify service pages load correctly
- Verify FAQ pages load correctly

Why these matter:

Technical accuracy prevents trust issues.

- Test all internal links
- Test all contact forms
- Test all call buttons
- Verify images display correctly
- Verify page titles exist
- Verify meta descriptions exist
- Verify author information appears
- Verify customer reviews display
- Verify service areas appear
- Verify page spelling
- Verify page grammar
- Verify mobile display

CHECKLIST #4: PRE LAUNCH CHECKLIST

CRITICAL ITEMS

- Publish complete business details
- Publish at least one service page
- Publish at least one FAQ page
- Publish author profile
- Publish customer reviews

PROFESSIONAL POLISH

- Add professional photographs
- Add clear call to action
- Add service area references
- Add page headings
- Add internal links
- Add contact page
- Add privacy policy
- Add enquiry form
- Add business opening hours
- Add social profile links

CHECKLIST #5: MISTAKE PROOF CHECKLIST

The 15 most common AI Search Engine Optimisation mistakes.

- Confirmed NOT using different phone numbers
- Confirmed NOT using different addresses
- Confirmed NOT publishing thin content
- Confirmed NOT copying competitor content
- Confirmed NOT leaving service areas blank

These mistakes reduce trust and visibility.

- Confirmed NOT publishing without reviews
- Confirmed NOT publishing without author information
- Confirmed NOT ignoring customer questions
- Confirmed NOT using generic page titles
- Confirmed NOT missing location references
- Confirmed NOT ignoring Search Console
- Confirmed NOT ignoring Analytics
- Confirmed NOT publishing broken links
- Confirmed NOT publishing duplicate pages
- Confirmed NOT leaving pages unfinished

CHECKLIST #6: MASTER CHECKLIST

PHASE 1: SETUP

- Record business information
- Create tracking sheet
- Connect Google tools
- Collect reviews
- Document competitors

PHASE 2: EXECUTION

- Publish service page
- Publish FAQ page
- Publish authority article
- Add local references
- Build citations

PHASE 3: QUALITY CHECK

- Test links
- Test forms
- Verify business details
- Verify mobile display
- Verify page quality

PHASE 4: LAUNCH

- Publish content
- Verify tracking
- Review visibility signals
- Review authority signals
- Schedule monthly review

BONUS: RED FLAG DETECTION LIST

If you see any of these, stop and fix immediately.

▶ **Different telephone numbers online**

→ Fix: Standardise every listing.

▶ **Different business names online**

→ Fix: Use one business name everywhere.

▶ **No customer reviews visible**

→ Fix: Publish verified reviews.

▶ **No service locations mentioned**

→ Fix: Add locations to key pages.

▶ **Thin service pages under 300 words**

→ Fix: Expand with useful information.

▶ **Generic page titles**

→ Fix: Add service and location keywords.

▶ **Missing author information**

→ Fix: Add expert author profile.

▶ **Broken internal links**

→ Fix: Repair all links.

▶ **Empty FAQ section**

→ Fix: Add ten customer questions.

▶ **No local case studies**

→ Fix: Publish recent project examples.

▶ **No tracking tools installed**

→ Fix: Connect Search Console and Analytics.

▶ **No monthly review process**

→ Fix: Schedule recurring audits.
